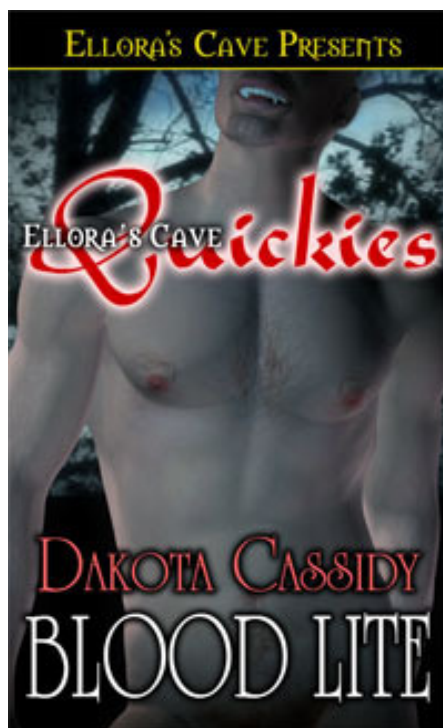




Blood Lite
