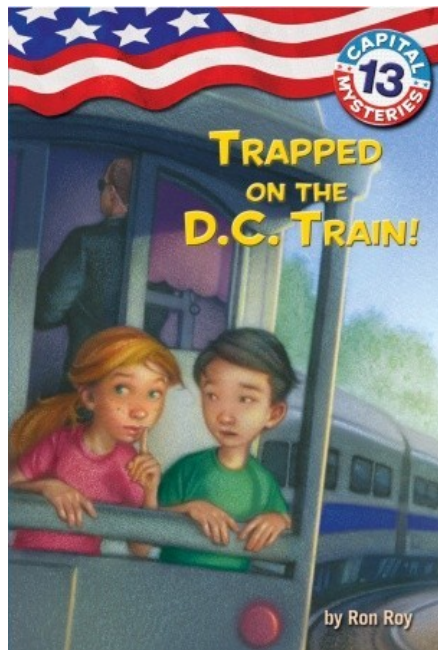




Trapped on the D.C. Train!
