I don't like secret babies but I understood Lacey's point in this story. While everything was a bit over the top and I guessed the villain pretty early on, I liked it enough to keep turning the pages.

This was a fast paced story about Lacey whose 15-year old daughter, Bethany, was kidnapped after returning back to her parent's house. Lacey asks for help from her old high school boyfriend, Mason, who is a U.S. Marshall. Will they find Bethany before it is too late? Who is seeking revenge on Lacey and using her daughter as a pawn? Will Lacey and Mason rekindle the flame from 15 years ago?
