I did like the page designs/layout. It worked well for this book. However, I felt as if some of the pictures were a little... dull in color, I think it is. They're not as high quality as they could be, while other pages are crisp. I think the lower quality comes from them using screenshots. For some reason, the screenshots aren't as high quality as the rest of the images.

Overall, it's a great book for young fans of the show, and it captures the Mane 6 well. If I was a lot younger, I might like it a little better. It's just really hard to judge it when there is no story being told.
