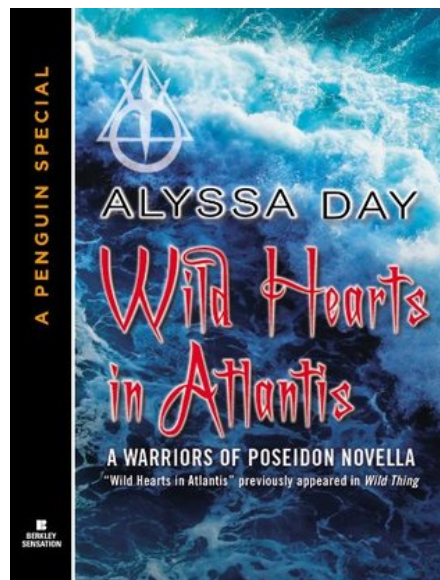

What an excellent novella in the Warriors of Poseidon series. Bastien and Kat are a great couple together and I really enjoyed the storyline. Fast paced and to the point. I gave 4 stars only because I wanted Bastien to get his own full book!

I guessed the main roamnce story line won't be very different (that to say, burst of passion from a first sight) and given how short the novellas is, I didn;t think there'd be time for much more.
