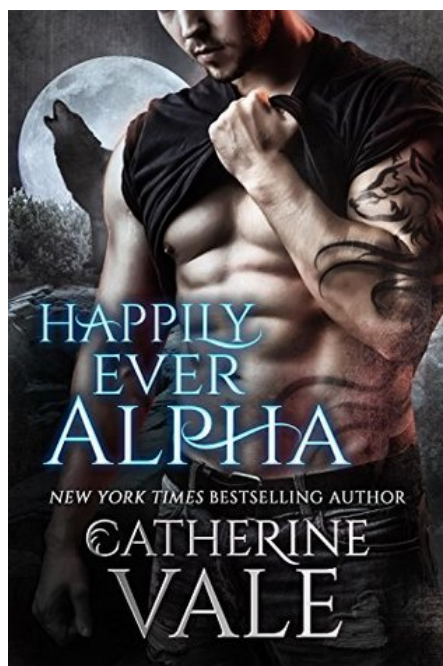




Happily Ever Alpha
