What i read was weirdly formatted and riddled with ridiculous errors - e.g., an incorrect usage of a name (Connor when it should have been Owen) and inconsistent descriptions ("aren't that many [shifters] in Dublin these days" and then a few sentences later "there are quite a few shifters there"). Errors like these scream one thing to me - the novel wasn't proofed by an editor or read by quality beta readers, and I'm going to be correcting grammar in my head and trying to figure out what the author means for the rest of the novel. No thanks. I read for entertainment, not so I can challenge my own patience. I'll pass unless another reader can convince me to give it another chance.
