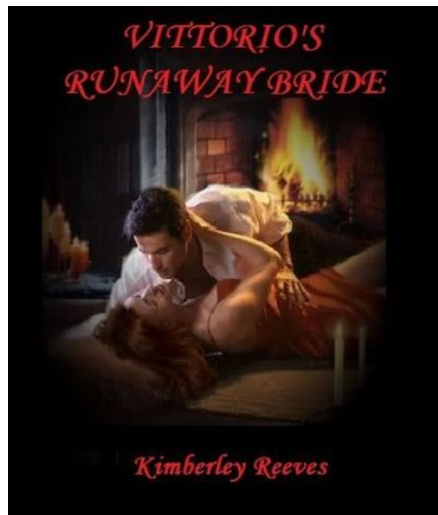




Vittorio's Runaway Bride
