The plot and blood-genie lore of *The Vampire Pendant* are refreshingly novel. A blood genie is a vampire-genie hybrid magically bound to a gem in fey-created jewelry. The blood genie comes out of the jewel to grant a wish to the wearer in exchange for feeding nightly on the blood of the wearer/wish recipient. The wish and the blood relationship last for only two weeks due to limitations of the blood genie's power and the spell.

Tessa lives as a recluse because her face was tragically burned when she was a teenager. Tessa's wish is to be perceived her as though she had no scars. The debonair blood genie, Anthony, lived as a mortal in Hollywood at its heyday as a successful architect. Unlike traditional vampire lore, Anthony explained that there is not usually sexual pleasure associated with blood feeding; however, Tessa and Anthony find themselves immediately aroused and attracted to one another during the feeding.

The sensual part of the romance lacked adequate literary foreplay and description needed to seduce this reader into vicariously enjoying the scenes. Nonetheless, the plot of *The Vampire Pendant* was enjoyable for a light, quick read that was acquired as a freebie.
