I liked these two books they were an enjoyable read.....but well of course there is a but.

#1 I found the first book to be way too short it was like they chopped 5 chapters out of it to fit the story into a certain number of pages - leaving out a ton of possible things to share with the reader about what happened to the characters. Out of nowhere the gypsy woman is now obviously Lily's Grandmother? I didn't buy it. And then the two characters are suddenly happy together and betrothed and end of story. We get nothing else. Nowhere in this book is there a mentions of two cousins that the 6 Montague children grew up with and who we meet in book #2.

Book #2 was short as well. Lisette is traveling through India to get a boat back to England and then suddenly she's off the boat and a ladie's maid. A whole section o the story of how that came about is left out. And she seems not too happy to be in England (then why did she travel there?? How long was she a maid before she made the trip? what are the odds that Lisette and Colonol Ross would make the trip at the same time? (zilch)) Why does the book bring up the aging Duke's horrible obsession with his grandchild and then just ends.....I guess its a series of books but really unnecessary to bring this in as it does nothing to enhance the plot of book #2. Again the book jumps over events that the reader would enjoy being a part of. How was Lisette's journey away from Castonbury? How was Ross's journey as he searched for the woman he just realizes he loves?? Instead we see them on the boat, married, and boom it ends.

I don't think it would take that much effort to raise these books up a notch. The plots are there but the delivery is lacking - even for a harlequin romance novel.
