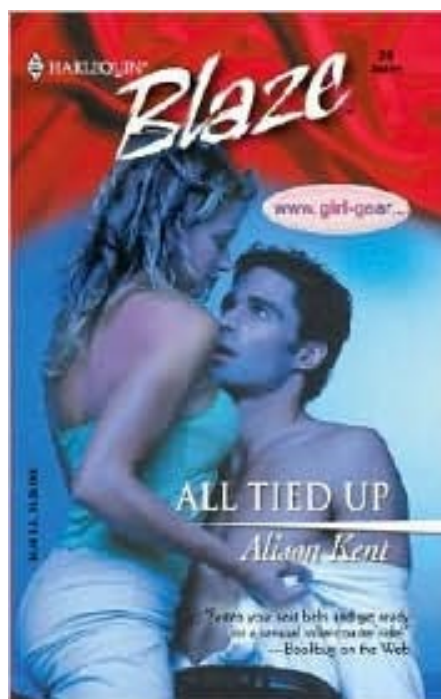




All Tied Up
