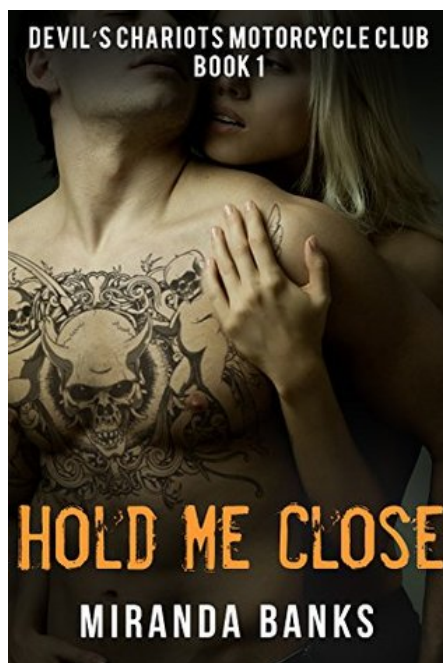




Hold Me Close

So much fuss is made of the club "law" that says an old lady can never be with anyone else in the club even after her man's death (never heard that one before)...and that is the main problem throughout the whole book. It seemed unbelievable and even though they both knew they could get in trouble, they kept tempting fate. It frustrated me how they would go back and forth with their feelings and it seemed the whole book went by with little progress.

It ends on a cliffhanger and we are left to wonder what will happen next...but I'm not sure I am invested in their story enough to find out.
