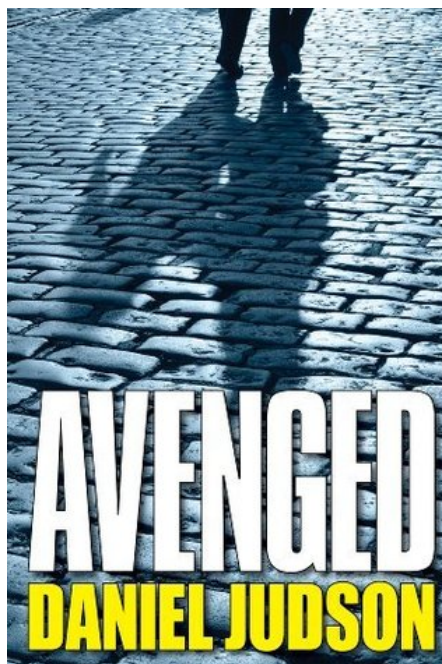

As with the previous books, Avenged is full of characters with flaws just trying to get by and hoping to make a better life. I found Avenged to be a taut, gripping novel, with interesting, well developed characters and good pacing - overall a very good read. The only reason why I did not give it five stars was due to the numerous typographical and grammatical errors.

While I have seen this issue previously in eBooks, this was by far the worst example I have experienced. It is bad enough when words are left out or misspelled, but when the actual context of a sentence is changed by the omission of a word, to me, that is simply careless transcription and proof reading (the case in point was a sentence where the action is negative, but the word "not" was left out, so in effect the reader has to figure out the proper context of the sentence).

If you can look past these errors, the chances are that you will really enjoy this novel.
