I think if there were illustrations on the "if you were. . ." pages, it would look better because right now there seems to be a lot of blank unused space. The "you" on the "but you're you that's who" page is different than the following two "you"s'. The only other thing I would change is the ending rhyme; it ends a bit abruptly. However in the big picture, as a book intended for toddlers, it's a nice short book. There are a few pages that have a lot of blank space, and that could effect the children's interest, if they don't have a lot to look at.
