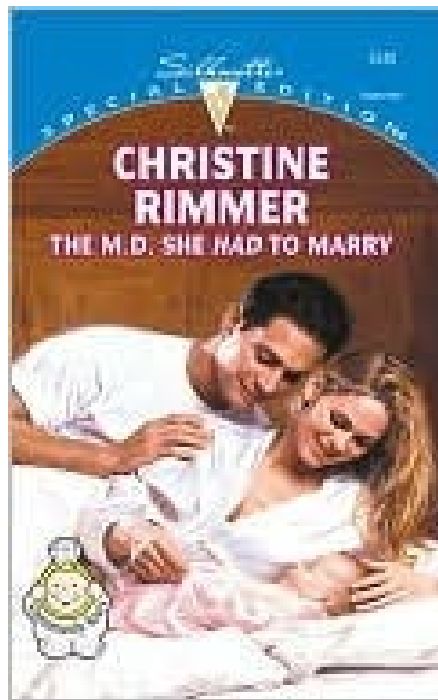




The M.D. She Had To Marry (Conveniently Yours)
