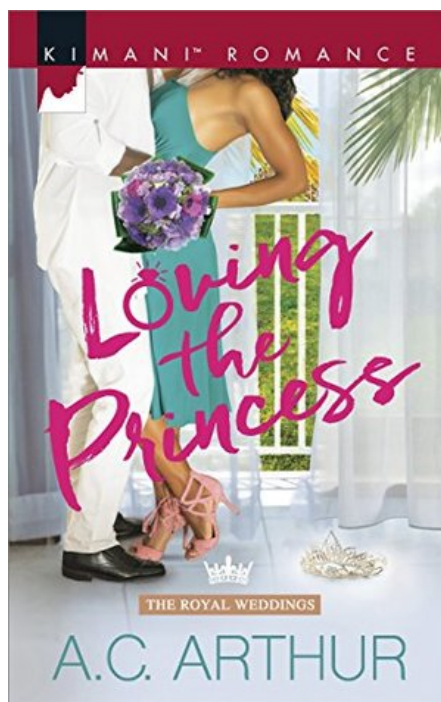




Loving the Princess
