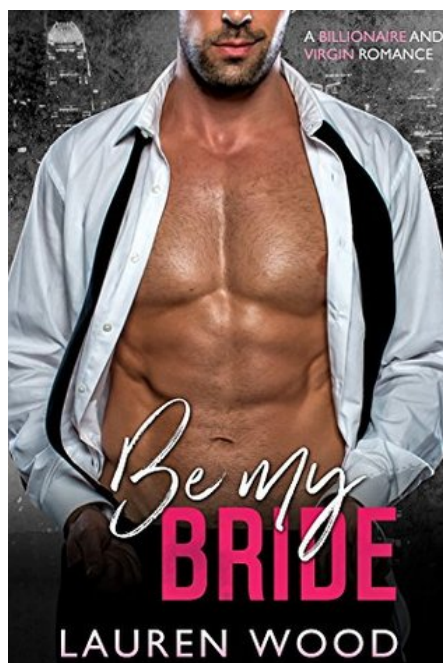




Be My Bride

I have mixed feelings about this book.

The writing in parts was very good, feelings expressed in a realistic way and I loved that Gemma did not give in to Keenan just because there was a strong attraction between them.

Gemma's father makes a business deal with Keenan, he will help him in business and in exchange Keenan marries his daughter who needs taking in hand.

I can only think that Gemma's father, Ronald Gary, can not have cared very much for his daughter, the book paints out that he loves her but he makes a deal with a womanizer, she has no say and she doesn't meet him until they are standing at the altar.

Gemma, I would have had more sympathy for her if she was independent and I don't know, got a job... she moans that she has no money as her father cuts her off until she agrees to the deal but she doesn't work, she likes art, fair enough but if she had been a struggling artist who worked part-time to help support herself but no she basically lives off her father and it never enters her head to try and stand up on her own to avoid the deal and support herself.

I think the author was trying to portray the difference between a work alcoholic and a free, not planning, free thinking person and how they can teach each other things about life but Gemma came across to me like a free loader.

Keenan.... where to start... I think her father saw potential in him but he views the marriage as a business deal, fair enough, when he sees her he wants her and she wants to wait until for someone she loves. He wants her and he is sexually frustrated when she turns him down, it's fair enough she has only just met him and doesn't have the morals of an alley cat. So as he's all worked up, he goes out and visits one of his old lady friends but the whole time he thinks of his wife so that's okay then. As they move in the same circles, his wife knows and tells him when he lectures her on fidelity in the marriage after a misunderstanding between her and another man.

I wanted her father to find out and confront him or her to go to her father and confront him on what sort of

wonderful man he picked out for her. Or maybe have a confrontation with the lady friend and have him grovel.

He does have to work to get her to come around to him and they are happy but to me it felt incomplete and the epilogue was just weird. At the same time it was strangely compelling.
