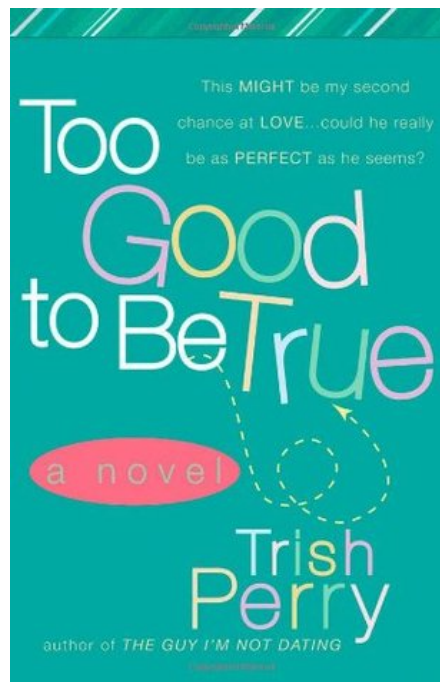




Too Good To Be True
