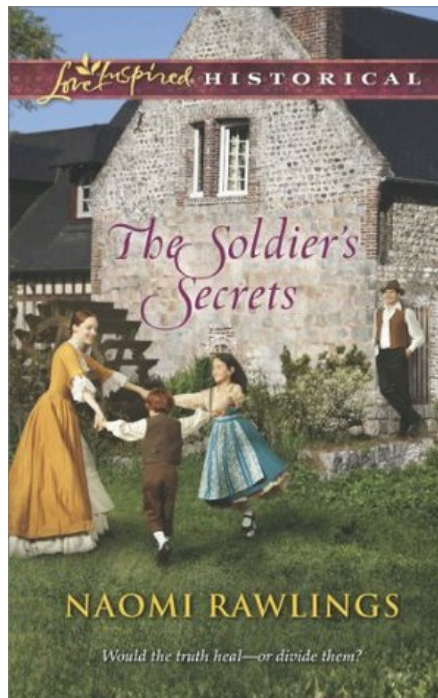

Brigitte Dubois, widow of a smuggler is forced by her mobster father-in-law to spy on Jean Paul Belanger. Alphonse Dubois suspects Jean Paul is the soldier who captured and executed his son and he wants revenge. But more importantly, Alphonse wants to entangle Brigitte and her children—his grandchildren into his criminal enterprise. Believing she must comply in order to save her children's lives, Brigitte assumes her maiden name and seeks employment with Jean Paul. Slowly she wheedles her way into his life. However, the more she learns about him the more she doubts he murdered her husband, and the more she discovers, the more she falls in love. Brigitte's beauty, poise and compassion melt Jean Paul's resistance, but he has secrets too . . . And Alphonse will not let the matter rest. Soon Brigitte must choose between her family's safety and her mission to entrap Jean Paul.
