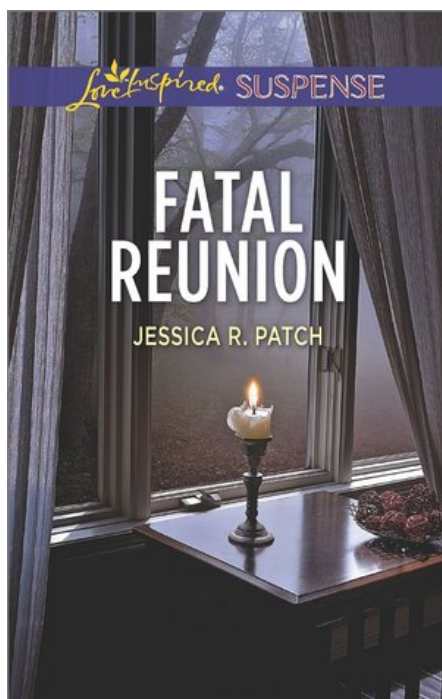




Fatal Reunion
