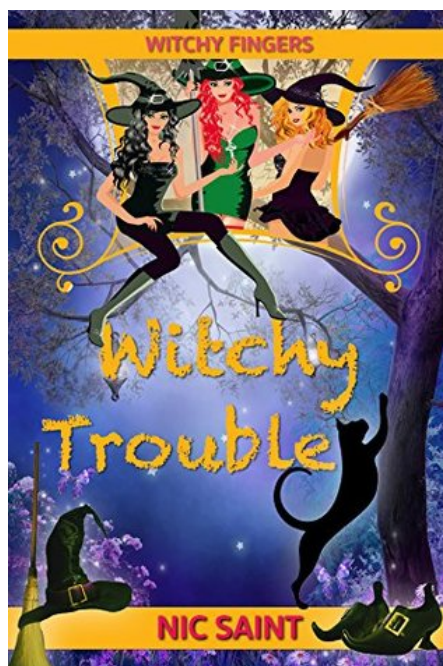




Witchy Trouble
