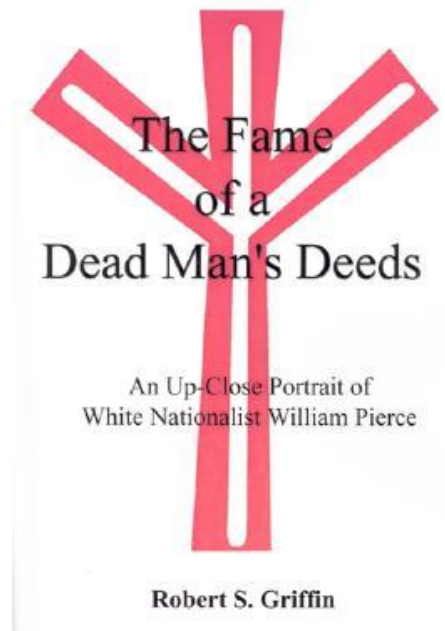




The Fame of a Dead Man's Deeds: An Up-Close Portrait of White Nationalist William Pierce
