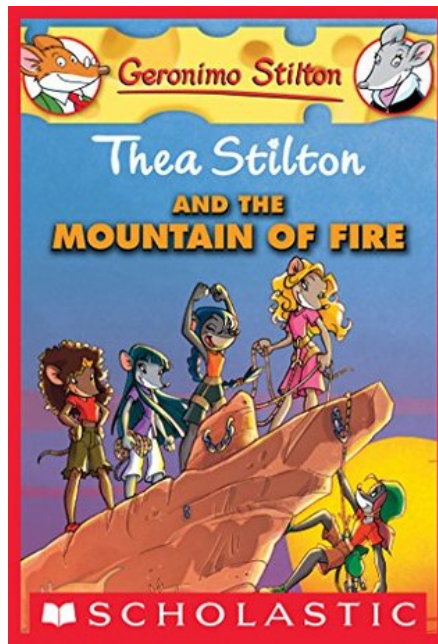




Thea Stilton and the Mountain of Fire

For those familiar with the Geronimo Stilton books, you might recognize that Thea is Geronimo's sister who teaches at Mouseford Academy. The Thea Sisters are five of her students who solve mysteries, this one being why sheep are getting sick on Nicky's grandmother's farm in Australia. (Drat that ruthless Mortimer MacCardigan!) Like other books in the series, it features cartoon illustrations and multi-colored graphics and different fonts sprinkled throughout the text, all designed to appeal to beginning chapter readers. As in the Magic Tree House series, readers learn information about the history and geography of the book's setting. Interesting sidebars provide facts for example about Aboriginal instruments and tools such as the bull-roarer, the Royal Flying Doctor Service of Australia that has served 24/7 since May 15, 1928, and the 200 million year old Wollemi Pine. And of course, add all of the given mouse puns (the food was "whisker-licking good) and you've got a pretty charming rodent detective series.
