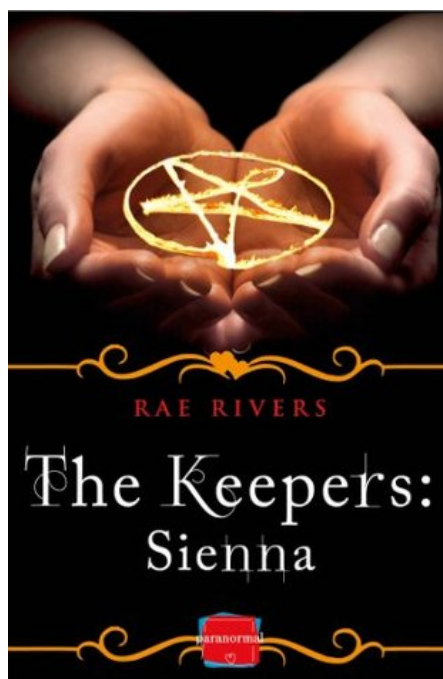

After falling in love with Rae Rivers, thanks to NetGalley and Harper Impulse for giving me a copy of The Keepers: Declan, I was very excited to begin the rest of the series. Sometimes starting a book from the middle of the series can lead to several questions and confusion, although Rivers comes across in her books with that being a case of wondering if the topic happened “off-screen” or in another book. Luckily, she articulates her stories in a way that without being redundant, you always know what’s going on without feeling like you’ve missed detrimental scenes.

The Keepers: Sienna is the prequel to the rest of the series, written after Archer, but if read first will explain what’s actually going on in Archer and Declan. I read Declan first, and now that I’ve read Sienna, so much of my curiosity was answered, so I highly recommend reading this first, but it’s not a necessity. Sienna’s book explains more about the sister, Sarah, that you only hear about in Archer and Declan. I had the jist of what happened from the other books, but reading this 70 page free prequel was a great way to freshen up the series for me before I began Archer.

Sienna and Archer are on the bud of a forbidden romance, stealing kisses in private places, risking the wrath of the Circle in order to be together. Do they anger the seeming mystical witches into cursing their love? Although that answer isn’t in Sienna, that’s definitely a question that even they were asking by end of the short story.

With new powers gifted to her by her grandmother, Sienna has very little control over the four elements, other than the fire she was born with. She fears the level of magic now at her disposal, and has internal struggles with the best way to wield the force, seemingly opting to ignore rather than accept.

Sarah, the sister to the three brothers Archer, Declan, and Ethan, is the laughter and joy of the family. She loves fiercely and protects what she loves. Seeing through her eyes throughout the story was bittersweet, and explains why she is cherished by so many.

Don’t let the amount of pages fool you! The Keepers: Sienna is an astonishing short story, full of love for one another, discovering the difficulties of choices made, elusive grandmothers, and treacherous predicaments. What an amazing beginning to a beautiful series!
