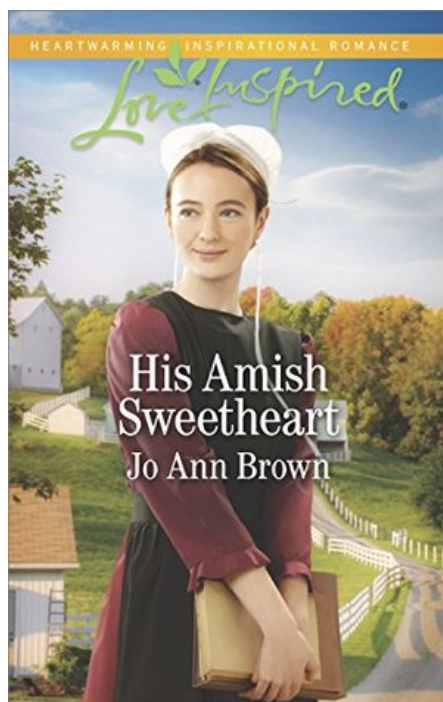




His Amish Sweetheart
