Every time I discover a new book in the Rag to Riches series I get very excited because I know I will enjoy whatever storyline E M Leya comes up with. The way she goes about tackling the issue of homelessness is to make it an integral part of the story, but as the series progresses, she made sure to develop her characters and make them unique. How they deal with homelessness varies and the homeless while living in similar situations are still completely developed complex individuals with their own unique histories.

Commitment-a-phobe Trevor is the chef and owner of a thriving, popular downtown restaurant. He built up his business on his own, since his politician father was ashamed of his gay and proudly out son. He went out of his way to avoid his sons unless he wanted Trevor and his younger brother, Dereck to be props for his Family Values campaign. Sixteen year-old Dereck is also gay with a serious addiction problem. Trevor fought to get Dereck proper care after gaining custody. That care included forced institutionalization in a Rehab Center.

Trevor played as hard as he worked. Usually with a different guy a few nights a week. He definitely had a reputation as a player and he didn't care. Most men were only interested in him for his money. So he wine, dined, danced with then f###ked them. Next..... He never brought them home. He had a small apartment above the restaurant - his Bachelor Pad. Trevor's real home was his refuge.

One night after he stayed late at the restaurant, he discovered a young man rummaging for food in the dumpster out back. He offers the young man a chance to shower, clean clothes and cooked him dinner. The repartee and chemistry between the two is amusing and smoking hot. Because of Trevor's decision not to accept any payment, he was treated to a magical evening. Prince as he preferred to be called, experienced something he never had before, a man who treated him decently, despite how they first met. Prince wanted to

give something in return. They were both honest with each other. It was refreshing and for some reason Trevor's one night rule extended to more with Prince. He had to fight Prince to accept gifts of clothes and food. Everyone wanted something from him except Prince.

Thoroughly intrigued Trevor offered him a job..."No". Help to get off the streets...."No". Kindness, consideration, and courtesy shocked Prince, but he gladly accepted them. But then Trevor never asked Prince to be more. He worried about him. He even extended his help to Prince's scared shy friend, Charles - No strings attached. Prince effected Trevor deeply. Even others began to notice. The deep impression was mutual and just as vehemently denied.

When they both finally realize the error of their decisions it was too late. Nearly fatal. This was an entertaining story. When he almost drops his garbage on Prince - literally - he only wanted to do a good deed and feed a homeless guy, at first. But the two of them soon find themselves entangled in an attraction neither of them can deny, yet also won't admit.
