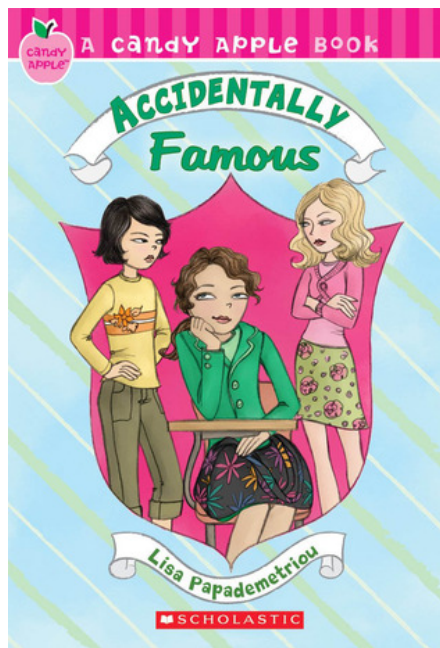




Accidentally Famous

So, it was better than not supporting a charity at all. But the donor's attitude kept her from deepening her heart, from growing inwardly, from appreciating others' plight, from giving from the heart, from learning compassion, from a thousand other things.

Another topic of discussion might be Amy's time management skills.
