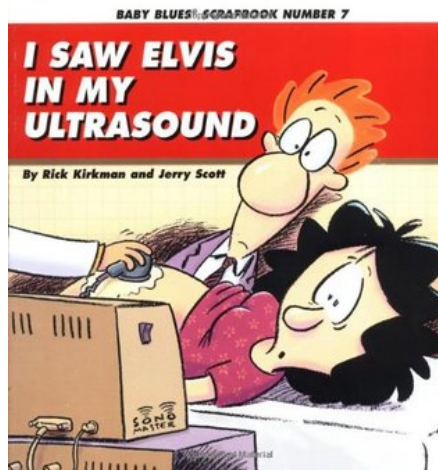




Baby Blues 07: I Saw Elvis In My Ultrasound
