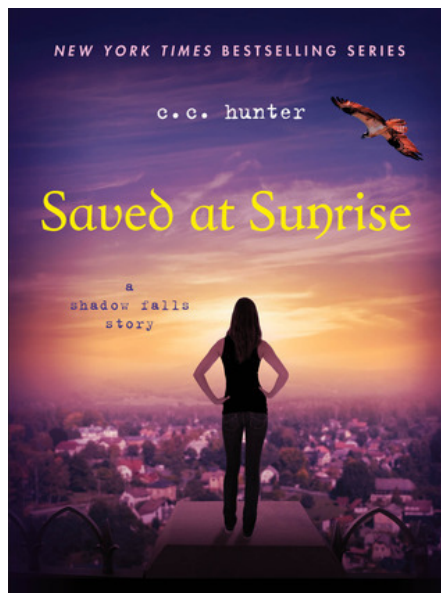

Ich selbst habe das eShort jetzt aber gelesen, nachdem ich erst die ersten beiden Shadow Falls Camp Bände gelesen habe und es hat mich nicht wirklich gespoilert. In Deutschland ist es als #0.5 des Spin Offs, Shadow Falls After Dark, also als kurze Vorschau zur neuen Serie um Della angegeben.

Meine Meinung: Bei Sonnenaufgang ist ein toller Einstieg zum neuen Spin Off der Shadow Falls Camp-Reihe, in dem sich dieses Mal alles um Vampirin Della dreht. Obwohl man von ihr in der ursprünglichen Reihe schon sehr viel mitbekommen hat, hat mich das eShort sehr begeistern können.
