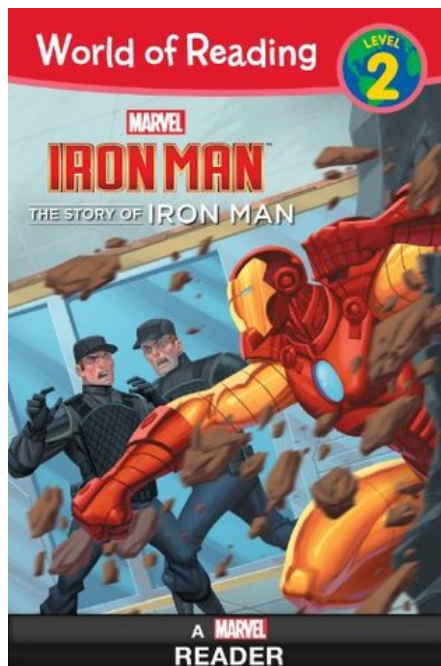

My 8 year old recently borrowed this book from our local library.

In this book, you find out how Iron Man became the hero he is and a little about who he was before he became Iron Man.

The book is a level 2 and states it is a Junior reader, which is recommended for Kindergarten-Grade 2. If your child reads for AR test at school, our school rates it as a 1.8, but I have seen level 2 books range anywhere from a 1-4 depending on the book. It really gets confusing. The book has a simple storyline, compound sentences, and contractions. Each page has colorful illustrations that go along with the sentences.

My son enjoyed the book. He had no issues with reading or understanding the text.

Of all of the easy reader comic books my 6-year-old son has been selecting from the library this spring (and there have been MANY) the World of Reading ones are my favorite. They seem to have the best sense of what an early reader can actually read. This is a level 2 book, recommended for K-Grade 2. S just finished kindergarten and was able to read this with me by taking turns reading pages. He needed some help but the book is set up in such a way that you can generally figure out the trickier words by referring to the illustrations.

The downside to keeping the text so simple is that sometimes my son wants to know more details than the text provides, but I'll take that trade-off to have something he can actually read.
