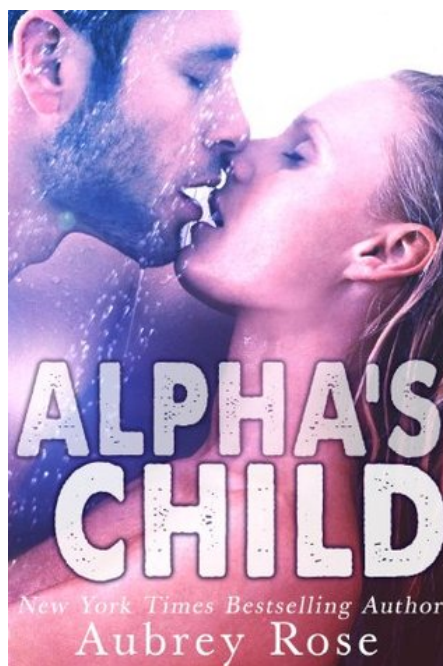




Alpha's Child
