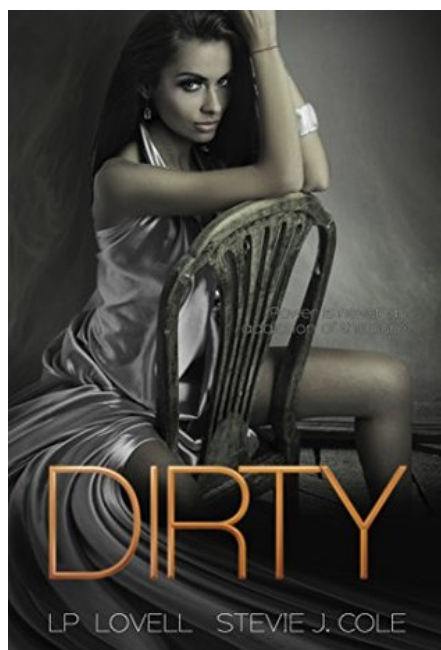




Dirty
