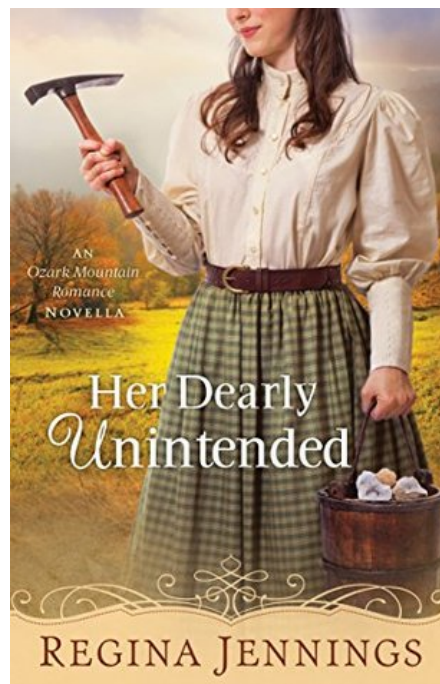




Her Dearly Unintended
