- I loved the rejection scene, so I really wish Aspen had made her guards suffer more. Instead, she just decided she would forgive them so she did. That was framed as a good, blessed thing, but I'm not holy and it annoyed me.
- One of the good things about this book was that we finally saw a threesome! It was fairly vanilla, as far as they go, but it still counts.

Negatives

- The guards asking for each other's permission to talk to sisters that weren't their own was super weird, especially because I don't recall that happening in the other books. Ffs, stop framing controlling behavior as romantic.
- The ending essentially contained awkward monologues, and I thought the whole thing could have been handled better.
- It was seemingly confirmed that this post-apocalyptic series took place in the past, and maybe there's a good reason most authors don't do that.
- Huge inconsistencies and wtf moments: (view spoiler)
- One of my biggest complaints about the series is that the guard blur together and aren't really developed all that well. Two of Aspen's guards have been around since the beginning of the series, so I thought Aspen's guards would be more developed than the others, which is why I was looking forward to this book.
